



BENEFACTOR FORM NOMINATION OF SHARES ON DEATH

You can use this form if you wish to tell us how you would like us to treat your shares of the Community Benefit Society that is The Green Gram Community Refill Shop Limited ("The Green Gram") in the event of your death.

Nomination of shares on your death: You can nominate a person (aged 18 or over) or organisation to whom you wish your shares to be transferred on your death. The Society will respect your wishes insofar as the law and our rules permit.

You could choose to nominate The Green Gram Community Refill Shop Limited which would in effect make it a beneficiary under your will.

The Green Gram is able to redeem up to £5,000 in shares without needing a Grant of Probate subject to the Society having sufficient funds available (the maximum number of shares invested will not exceed £1,250 so there will not be any issue with probate).

If you choose not to nominate anyone your executors will deal with your shares as part of the administration of your estate and can apply to have them redeemed.
