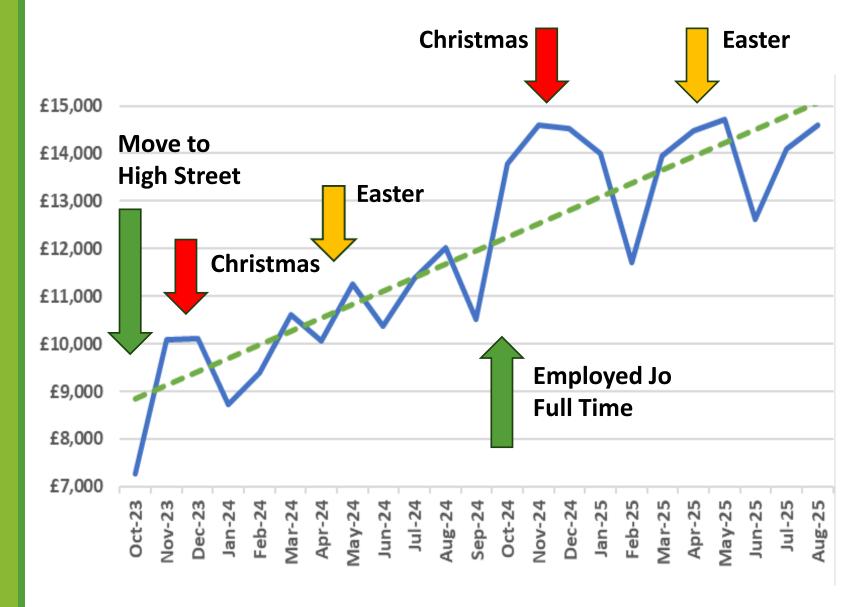

The Green Gram is still growing!

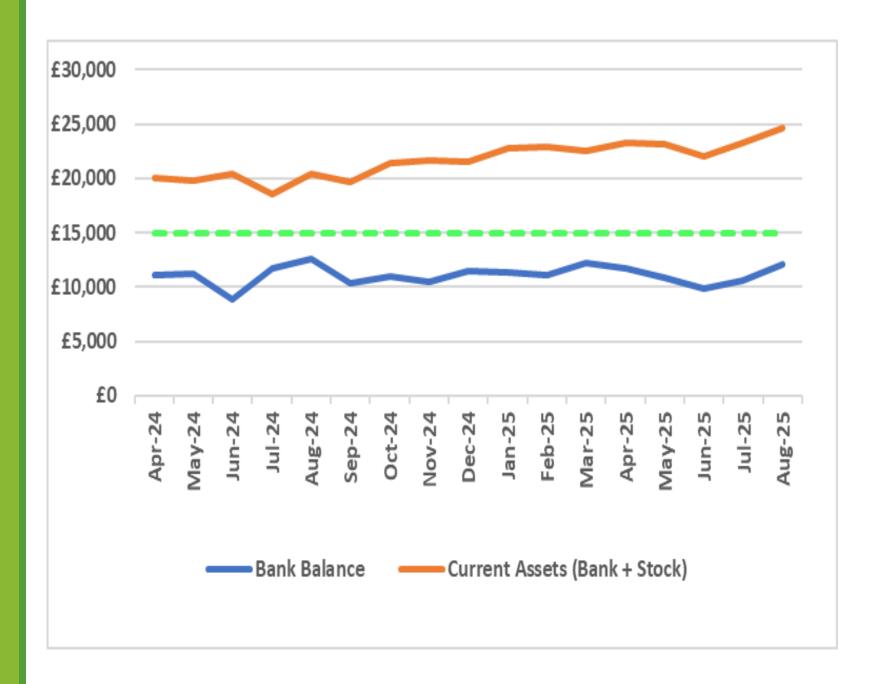
- The trend is still up with sales having doubled since moving into the High Street!
- Turnover from the previous set of accounts has increased by 57%. In financial terms nearly £50,000

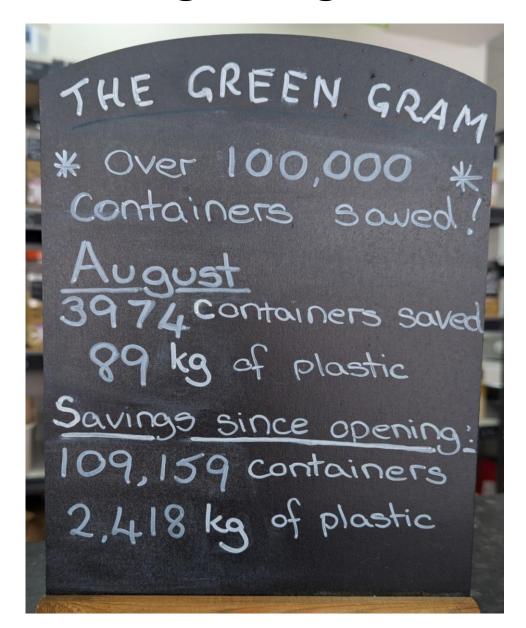

- Nearly 50,000 containers have been saved in the last 12 months
- We have saved an estimated 110,000 containers since opening.
- Weighing in at over 2 ½ tons!

Reducing Waste!



- Thousands of donated containers have been reused
- Most plastic containers are returned to the supplier for reuse (SESI, Faith in Nature, Coffee tubs, Oil containers)
- Buying in bulk means less packaging and less plastic
- Reuse rather than buy new 2nd hand peanut butter machine, coffee grinder, dishwasher, sweet jars from The Alcove.
